The applicant must call Gopher State One Call for utility locates prior to beginning work. The applicant should be aware that there may be additional underground and overhead utilities located within the right-of-way and that they are responsible for any damage incurred during activities related to this application.

It will be the applicant's responsibility to dispose of debris, keep disturbance of vegetation to a minimum, and reestablish turf with grass seed and mulch. Disturbed areas currently mowed and used as lawns should be restored with sod. No open trenching across paved streets will be allowed, and all crossings of paved surfaces must be bored. Any settlement or damage shall be repaired at the applicant's expense. If the disturbed areas extend outside the City right-of-way, the applicant must obtain the owner's written permission prior to construction in order to enter the property. Any above ground or below ground facilities disturbed by the applicant must be restored to their original condition (i.e. mailboxes, culverts, roadway signs, etc.). Excavations must be made in a fashion that will minimize disruption by using either open trenching (in non-paved areas only) or boring.

The applicant shall be responsible for providing adequate traffic control during construction.

The applicant must provide a performance bond or cashier's check in the amount of \$5,000 to the City of St. Mary's Point as assurance that all damage to the right-of-way or to any other utility that should occur in the construction process will be repaired.

The permit request needs to specify the exact location of the proposed facility, and a preliminary time schedule needs to be identified on the permit request. If a permit is to be issued, the permit will be "time limited" indicating that the work must be completed by a certain date.

The applicant will agree to pay any applicable permit application fees and to reimburse the City of St. Mary's Point for any engineering fees, legal fees, and inspection costs, etc. that are incurred during the planning and construction of this project. In addition to the City of St. Mary's Point, other agencies may have jurisdiction or approval authority over the proposed improvements (i.e., Washington County, DNR, etc.). It is the applicant's responsibility to contact these agencies and obtain any necessary permits when required.
